



HEAD WRAP

Our **Satin Creations (Reversible) Head Wraps** are an essential accessory for the person wanting to cover the head on any given day. Whether to cover the head due to hair loss as a result of medication or a medical condition, between touch-ups, bald spots, or to protect the head from the sun, our satin Head Wraps are a stylish addition to your ensemble.

- **Satin Creations Head Wraps** are reversible and can be tied in several different ways to achieve the desired look.

Step 1. Place wrap on the head with the long tail-ends draped down the back. Turn the edge up around the face to display the reverse side of the wrap. At the back of the head, at the neckline tie a half knot to secure the wrap against the head.

To obtain the different styles, follow the instructions listed below:-

Casual Look

- A**
1. Perform Step 1.
 2. Pull both ends over the left or right shoulder to drape over chest
- B**
1. Perform Step 1.
 2. Bring each end separately over each shoulder to front of body.



Every Day Look

1. Perform Step 1.
2. Separately twist each end a few times and bring forward (one on either side of the head) to meet at the top of the head.
3. Tie a knot to secure the wrap on the head.
4. Tuck the ends in under the side of the wrap.



Out-and-About Look

1. Perform Step 1.
2. Tie bow at back at neck.
3. Expand bow to show alternative color.



Sophisticated Look

1. Perform Step 1.
2. Twist both ends together and wrap around itself to form a "Chignon" at the nape of the neck and tuck in loose ends.



The Mystery Look

1. Place wrap on top of head
2. Turn the edge up around the face to display the reverse side of the wrap.
3. Keep tail-ends at the front, criss-cross ends under chin around the neck and tie a half-knot at back of neck.
4. To achieve the finished look, add Dark Sun Glasses.



The Exclusive Cover Up

1. Place wrap on top of head. Make sure the forehead is covered.
2. Tie the tail ends of the Head Wrap around to the back of the neck, crisscross and continue around to the front wrapping the neck and tie a loose half-knot at back.
